The ideal candidate must:

- Be in possession of a qualification at MQF Level 6 in Social Work, Psychology or a related area. Candidates who are in possession of a social worker's warrant would be given preference.
- Have a minimum of two (2) years' experience within the social welfare and community field.
- Be committed to achieving positive outcomes for children and vulnerable adults.
- Be able to work independently and as part of a team.
- Be competent in oral and writing skills, both in Maltese and English.
- Be confident in taking responsibility for his/her own professional opinion.
- Be willing to travel in order to participate in assignments overseas.
